Drive, don't fly

Even though your seatbelt is not a new technology, it's still the number-one safety device in the event of an accident.

Do you know if your cab is R29 compliant?

R29 is a **cab integrity test** that checks how safe you are in a collision.

Anti-lock Braking Systems help keep your rig straight when you have to stand on the brakes.
